ServeWell Breath Guard Installation Instructions

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ATTENTION!


Do not remove the protective paper from the acrylic panels. The paper will protect the panels from being scratched during installation

Refer to *fig. 1* for the following steps.

- 1. Remove the black plugs from the top of the end surface of the unit.
- 2. Center the uprights on the end of the units and note the threaded inserts that will be used.
- 3. Place 1 ea. spacer over the two threaded inserts that will be used to fasten the uprights. The spacer should be completely covered by the foot of the upright.
- 4. Fasten uprights with screws provided to the work surface making sure to face the weld studs for the end panel to the <u>outside</u> of the unit.
- 5. Replace the black plugs in any unused exposed inserts.

NOTE: The spacer installed in step 3 should be completely covered by the foot of the upright.

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CAUTION!

Do not over tighten the palnuts in the following steps. Over tightening the palnuts will cause cracking of the acrylic panel

Before beginning the following steps, carefully peal back the protective paper from around the holes in the acrylic. Do not peal the protective paper off the entire piece of acrylic.

Refer to fig. 2 and 3 for the following steps.

- 6. Install the top panel (long FLAT panel) to the top of the uprights using the palnuts provided.
- 7. Install the end panels using the palnuts provided.
- 8. Install each side panel to the sides of the upright using the palnuts provided
- 9. Install the center brace to the side panels using the screw and palnuts provided.

10. Remove the remaining paper from the acrylic panels.

<u>Cleaning and Maintenance</u>

ATTENTION!

Do not use coarse or rough paper towels or ammonia based cleaners to clean acrylic panels. It will cause fogging and may scratch the panel.

- Use a soft cloth when cleaning the acrylic panels. A glass cleaner that does not contain ammonia or an acrylic polish may be used.
- The appearance of small scratches may be reduced with the use of a polish specially formulated for acrylic panels.
